## This terms theme: Superhero me!

This term we will be learning all about ourselves and people who help us.

In Literacy we will explore how to write our names, learning our sounds and matching the initial sounds to words, i.e. m—mouse.

In Maths we will be exploring numbers, what they look like, how we can make them and what order they go in.

We will practice naming our body parts and exploring our senses. Looking at everyday superheroes such as firefighters and doctors and how they help us.
