Our topic for this term is Helping hands. We will be completing lots of activities this term to explore how we can help others.



Warmer weather

English

The children will be continuing with Literacy or RWI lessons this term. Our book for this term is Grandad's Secret Giant by David Litchfield, the book explores how a secret giant helps the community of Gabelview. We will be looking at non-fiction writing and creating our own stories.

In guided reading we will be exploring a variety of traditional tales and our class read will be the BFG by Roald Dahl.

Numeracy

In Maths this term we will be exploring statistics and revisiting time and money. We will also be exploring problem solving tasks in which the children will need to use a range of learnt strategies to solve problems.

Geography

In Geography we will be exploring the 7 continents and five oceans, learning their names and where they are on a map. We will also be looking at the differences between human and physical geographical features.

Science

This term we will be continuing to explore plants. The children will be planting seeds in our outside area. Developing an understanding of what seeds and bulbs need to grow and exploring where our food comes from.
